

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Regular Show Fan Dubbing 2026 – Cartoon Network COMPETITION

(Competition)

By entering the Competition, each Entrant (as defined below) unconditionally accepts and agrees to comply with these terms and conditions (**Rules**), and agrees to be bound by the decisions of the Promoter in respect of the interpretation of these Rules and otherwise in relation to the Competition. Entrants who do not comply with the Rules will not be eligible to win the Prize (as defined below).

Please read the Rules carefully.

1. **Eligibility Requirements**

Subject to the provisions of paragraph 6 below, this Competition (the **Promotion**) is open to all persons who are resident of South Africa. All entrants who are under eighteen (18) years of age must have parental/guardian consent to enter this Promotion and their parent or guardian must agree to these Terms for themselves and on behalf of the entrant. By entering this Promotion each entrant confirms that he/she has obtained such consent and agrees to be bound by these Terms and confirms that he or she has obtained the required parental/guardian consent. (the **Entrants**).

The Competition begins at 09:00 AM SAST on Friday 29 May 2026 and ends at 19:00 PM SAST on Sunday 14 June 2026 (the **Competition Period**).

2. **How to Enter**

2.1 **No purchase is necessary to take part in this Competition.**

Entrants may enter the Competition by:

- (a) Visiting the Cartoon Network Africa Regular Show dubbing booth (the **Booth**) at the following locations / dates:

- Johannesburg, Cresta Shopping Centre, 29 – 31 May
- Bloemfontein, Mimosa Mall, 5 -7 June
- Durban, The Pavillion Shopping Centre, 12 – 14 June

The Booth will be open during mall opening hours.

- (b) Agreeing to and signing all necessary terms & conditions and release forms (with parents/guardians agreeing and signing for all entrants under eighteen (18) years of age).

- (c) Recording their version of the “Regular Show” short clip in one of four South African languages (IsiZulu, IsiXhosa, Afrikaans or Sesotho) via *the Booth*

No other forms of entry will be accepted.

After the conclusion of the Competition Period, four (4) winners of the Competition (**Competition Winner(s)**) will be selected by a panel of judges, from amongst all valid Entries, based on the skill, originality and humour of their recording.

Turner’s decision concerning the determination of the Competition Winner(s) and all matters relating to the Competition will be final and binding.

3. Prizes

Four (4) winners will each receive:

- (a) A one-hour dubbing session in a professional dubbing studio in Johannesburg, where winners will record a voice over for a character in the Regular Show (in one of the languages listed above) to be used for promotional purposes, including return transportation to and from the studio for the winner and a companion (or parent/guardian where the winner is under 18 years of age).
- (b) The chance to have their Regular Show dubbed extract, alongside their image, shown on the Cartoon Network Africa channels, including but not limited to on-air, YouTube and Meta.

Prize Terms and Conditions

- Winners will be contacted via the email & phone number provided in the release form to Turner;
- The winners dubbed extract will be used for promotional purposes by Turner, it will not appear in the main programme of The Regular Show.
- Date of recording session will be decided by Turner, based on winners and studio availability.
- Return, same day, transportation to and from the recording studio in Johannesburg will be provided for the winner (and their parent/guardian if winner is under 18). Transportation will be by economy travel on a mode of transportation and timing at the sole discretion of Turner. If winner wishes to travel on alternative modes of transport or times to those arranged, this will be at winners' sole expense and responsibility.
- The prize does not include accommodation, or any other expenses not expressly referred to in these terms and conditions;
- The prize has an approximate commercial value of ZAR 8, 500 per winner, which may vary depending on transport / winners

4. Notifying the Competition Winner

The Competition Winner(s) will be informed by the Promoter within 6 weeks following the end of the competition, via the email or phone number provided in the release form they filled out to enter the Competition,. The Competition Winner(s) will be required to confirm acceptance of their Prize in a direct message within forty eight (48) hours after receipt of notification of the Prize (**Confirmatory message**). The Competition Winner(s) must provide their full name, telephone number and mailing address in the Confirmatory message. The Promoter will inform the Competition Winner(s) of any arrangements for the redemption of the Prizes. Should the Competition Winner fail to respond within the allocated time frames, the Prize will be forfeited.

5. Winner(s)' List

Where required by local law, the name of the Competition Winner(s) may be available upon request. 6. **Promoter**

The Competition is organised by Turner Broadcasting System France SAS (the **Promoter** or **Turner**).

In order to administer the Competition, the Promoter may make use of advertising and promotional agencies (**Turner Agents**).

No employee or family member of an employee of the Promoter or its affiliated companies, subcontractors, agents or assigns or anyone else professionally connected with the Promotion is permitted to enter the Promotion.

7. **Prize Terms**

Prizes are subject to availability. The Promoter takes reasonable care to ensure that the Prizes are as described in these Rules. However, events may occur that make the awarding of the Prize impractical or inappropriate due to unforeseen circumstances or reasons beyond the control of the Promoter. In this situation, the Promoter may vary or amend the Prize to provide a reasonable alternative as a result of which the Promoter or parties connected to the Promoter shall not be held liable.

No cash or credit alternative is available and the Prizes are not transferable. Eligibility for the Prize may be subject to signing Turner Prize Acceptance Form (available on request).

Where applicable, the Competition Winner(s) will be required to sign a Prize Acceptance Form within seven (7) days of the date of issuance. If the Prize Acceptance Form is not returned within the specified time period, the Prizes will be forfeited.

If a Competition Winner does not confirm acceptance of the Prize within the required time period, he/she will automatically forgo their right to claim the Prize and a runner up will be selected as an alternative Competition Winner. If such runner up also fails to accept the Prize in the required manner, the next runner up will be selected as an alternative Competition Winner and so on until another Competition Winner is chosen and has duly accepted in accordance with these Rules.

8. **Changes to Rules**

Subject to applicable law, the Promoter reserves the right to modify the Rules at any time without notice to Entrants. In such circumstances, updated Rules will be uploaded to and published on the Website

10. **Eligibility of Entries**

10.1 Ineligible or fraudulent Entries are void. All Entrants will be deemed to have authorised the Promoter and Turner Agents to check the completeness and accuracy of the information they supply for purposes of participation. An Entrant who has supplied incomplete, inaccurate or fraudulent information will be automatically disqualified. Any Entry that uses offensive or inappropriate language will automatically be disqualified.

10.2 Where the Competition entry mechanism involves public voting, Turner reserves the right to disqualify any Entrant to the extent permitted by applicable law, if in Turner's sole discretion, the Entrant is considered to have manipulated or influenced the Competition outcome through fraudulent or dishonest means including, but not limited to, automated means and vote exchange forums or groups.

10.3 The Promoter and Turner Agents are not responsible for lost, late, or misdirected Entries, for technical, hardware or software failures of any kind, for lost or unavailable network

connections, or for failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed computer transmissions or any human error which may occur in the receipt or processing of the Entries.

- 10.4 Proof of entering information via the Booth does not constitute proof of delivery or receipt of such information. Turner is not responsible for the failure of any Entry to be received by it on account of technical problems.
- 10.5 Use of computer programs and other automatic means to enter the Competition is prohibited and may result in the disqualification of the Entrant.
- 10.6 The Competition is not open to employees or contractors of the Promoter, Turner Agents, Turner group of companies, including each of their affiliates, subsidiaries, divisions, or Facebook, or Twitter, or any person directly or indirectly involved in the organisation or running of the Competition or their direct family members.
- 10.7 In the event of a dispute regarding the identity of the person submitting an Entry, the Entry will be deemed to be submitted by the person in whose name the e-mail account is registered on the date the Entry is submitted. All Entries become property of the Promoters and will not be returned.
- 10.8 Entries shall not be returned to Entrants.

11. Post-Competition Publicity

The Competition Winner(s) may be invited and agree to take part in post-Competition publicity as may be requested by the Promoter. By accepting the Prizes, to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the Competition Winner(s) consent that the Promoter may use his/her name, photograph, likeness (including his/her voice), hometown and biographical information and statements concerning the Competition or the Promoter and/or its products without further compensation or notice for the purpose of advertising, promotion, and merchandising, throughout the world in perpetuity, and the Competition Winner(s) grant all rights to edit or modify and to publish and copyright such details.

12. Use of Personal Data

- 12.1 In order to participate in the Competition, Turner requires Entrants to provide certain information about themselves on the Website, such as Entrant's name, contact details and social media details. Some Entries may require the submission of user generated content (such as, pictures, videos, etc.), which may contain personal data. Turner has specified which information is mandatory in order to participate in the Competition.
- 12.2 Submitted information will be used by Turner to administer the competition, which is in Turner's legitimate interest. Entry information will usually be kept until the competition is fully administered, but in any event, no longer than six (6) months.
- 12.3 Turner may require Competition Winner(s) to provide additional information in order to fulfil the Prize. This information may be shared with Turner's partners involved in the fulfilment of the Prize, e.g. prize providers.
- 12.4 Turner may use cookies and other similar technologies to keep track of your interactions on the Website and offer you a more personalised experience. Please visit here for further information. As not all Website(s) are owned or operated by Turner please see any third party privacy policies made available on the Website.
- 12.5 You have a right to access your personal data; to request that it be updated, deleted and/or restricted; and object to its processing upon legitimate grounds by visiting

<https://www.warnermediaprivacy.com/>. You also have a right to lodge a complaint with your local data protection authority.

13. Limitation of Liability

- 13.1 The Promoter and Turner Agents do not accept any responsibility for any occurrences resulting from the Entrants' connection to the internet via the Website and/or resulting from participation in the Competition. In particular, the Promoter and Turner Agents do not accept responsibility for any damage or loss caused in any way to Entrants, their computer equipment and/or to data which is stored on any such equipment, or to their personal, professional or commercial activities.
- 13.2 If, for any reason, the Competition is not capable of running as planned, including infection due to computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure, human error or any other causes beyond the control of Turner that corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of the Competition, Turner reserves the right to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, and to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the Competition and let the Promoter select the Competition Winner(s) from all eligible Entries received prior to the cancellation or termination of the Competition.
- 13.3 In the event of unforeseen circumstances, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute any or all parts of the Competition. In this event, such a change will be publicised on the Website and any necessary amendments to these conditions will be made.
- 13.4 Entrants agree to the fullest extent allowed by applicable law to release and forever discharge Turner, and its parent corporations, subsidiaries, assigns and employees, and any entity or person connected with the Competition from and against any and all claims, demands, losses and liabilities of any nature whatsoever which may now or hereafter arise, including but not limited to any loss of enjoyment, costs, delays or other harm or loss of any nature whatsoever caused by, contributed to, or arising out of or in connection with the Prizes.
- 13.5 If any court or competent authority decides that any of the provisions of these Rules are invalid, unlawful or unenforceable to any extent, the Rule will, to that extent only, be severed from the remaining Rules, which will continue to be valid to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 13.6 Any attempt by an Entrant to deliberately damage the Website or to undermine the legitimate operations of the Competition may be a violation of criminal and civil laws and should any such attempt be made, the Promoter reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 13.7 The Promoter reserves the right to change, suspend or cancel the Competition without specifying the reasons for its decision and without incurring liability as a result. These Rules will apply to the Competition. The Promoter reserves the right to modify these Rules at any time prior to, during or after the Competition Period.
- 13.8 Turner does not exclude any liability for death or personal injury arising as a result of Turner's negligence in respect of the Entrants' use of the Website.
- 13.9 By entering the Competition, Entrants agree to release any social networking site that the Competition may be accessed through from any and all liability connected with the Competition.

13.10 If applicable law does not allow all or any part of the above limitation of liability to apply, the limitations will apply only to the extent permitted by applicable law.

13.11 The Competition is governed by the laws of your country of residence. You hereby consent and submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of your country of residence for any action however so arising out of these Rules.
